
How to Install an Operating System on a USB Drive

Step 1:

1. Download the OS file (mind-os-vx.zip) and then decompress the file.

Step 2:


- 1. Prepare a USB drive with at least 16GB of space, and format the USB drive.
- 2. Format the USB drive to NTFS (for Mind) or exFAT (for Mind 2 and Mind 2 Al Maker Kit) and set the volume label to WINPE.



Step 3:

1. After formatting, paste the decompressed OS files to the USB drive.

Note: please ensure that all the required files are copied accurately without any missing files and the byte size of the system files matches the size of the local files.



1. Restart your computer and press F7.
